The Riveters program is open to women of all skill levels and backgrounds. Whether lacing up skates for the first time or returning to the ice, every player will find camaraderie, mentorship, and purpose in a mission-driven environment.

By bringing together those who have served and those who support, the Riveters are not only strengthening bonds among women, they're also helping shape a more inclusive and dynamic future for the sport of hockey in Metro Detroit.
